



AEI database of research on international education

AEI commissioned the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER) to develop a searchable database of research relevant to international education. The database, which is freely accessible from AEI's website (see below), contains details of over 6,000 books, articles, conference papers and reports. Users can quickly locate research relevant to their needs and keep up-to-date with emerging trends and significant publications in international education.

Material in the database is drawn from the Australian Education Index, produced by ACER's Cunningham Library, with additional material sourced from a variety of international organisations and publishers.

The database includes international and Australian research (including AEI research) from 1990 onwards and, where available, includes links to the full text of documents. The database also includes useful features such as links to: journals and newsletters on international education; over 60 other relevant websites; international education publishers; and other searchable education databases.

The database can be easily searched using a number of different criteria, including: subject; publication title; author; publishing organisation; year of publication; country (both subject and origin); as well as type of document (ie. journal, research report, book, conference paper, etc). The following example illustrates a search for research undertaken by AEI on international education in China and the result:
